2. INTRODUCTION

The Karate1 - Premier League is the most important league event in the world of Karate. It comprises of a number of the most prominent Karate competitions and endeavours to bring together the best Karate athletes in the world in an open Championships of unprecedented scale and quality.

Initiated in 2011, the 2024 edition is formed by four events being held in the cities of Paris, Antalya, Cairo and Casablanca thus stating Karate's impact all around the world and its global scale.

At the final Premier League event 2024, the top-ranked athletes in each category are presented with the "Grand Winners" award. In order to be eligible to receive the "Grand Winners" award, competitors must participate in at least 3 events.

The Karate 1 – Premier League Paris 2024 will be held from 26th to 28th of January in 2024 at Stade Pierre de Coubertin, Paris (16e).








7.1 New competition System

The competition system consists of two different phases:

Round Robin Phase

The number of pools and athletes per pool depends on the number of competitors registered. This information is detailed in the **WKF World Ranking Rules**.

8. EVENT RANKING

Competitors can earn ranking points in every Karate 1 event according to the official WKF-Ranking as can be seen in Section 2 (Points per Place) and Section 4 (Points Calculating System) of the WKF Ranking Rules.

The Applicable Ranking will be the one updated on the day of the registration opening:

EVENT RANKING

9. ONLINE REGISTRATION & OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION

All registration in a Premier League event must be processed ONLINE.

No registration will be accepted after the official online registration deadline and all requests will be declined.

Onsite registrations will NOT be accepted.

The registration will be validated once the online payment is completed through the online payment platform.





9.1 Online Registration Process

The registration starts two (2) months prior to the event, on 26 November 2023 at the 12:00 h GMT +0 and close fifteen (15) days before the tournament, on 11 January 2024 at the 12:00 h GMT +0 and it is divided in the following three phases (all phases will open and close at the 12:00 h GMT +0 of the listed day);

PHASE 1

From 26 November 2023 (first week for registration)

Registration only by NFs for athletes classified between the positions 1 and 32 (included) in the Event Ranking

No limit of athletes per NF

From 04 December 2023 (second week for registration)

Open registration for athletes classified between the positions 1 and 32 (included) in the Event Ranking

No limit of athletes per NF

PHASE 2

From 12 December 2023 (next two weeks of registration)

If vacancies, open registration <u>for athletes ranked between positions 33 and 64</u>
(included) in the Event Ranking

No limit of athletes per NF.

PHASE 3

From 20 December 2023 (last two weeks of registration)

If vacancies, open inscription <u>for competitors ranked between positions 65 and 100</u>
(<u>included</u>) in the Event Ranking

No limit of athletes per NF.





Non-Reported Absences

- Any cancellation of an online registration must be <u>for a justified and duly accredited cause</u> and must be communicated in writing to the WKF (<u>wkf@wkf.net</u>) at least <u>48 hours before the first day of the competition</u>. <u>Title</u>: PL Absence + (event) + (WKF ID)
- 2. In case of an unjustified absence, the athlete will not be able to register in the following **TWO** (2) Karate 1 Premier League events.
- 3. If the unjustified absence occurs at the last Karate 1 Premier League event of the year, the athlete in question will not be eligible for the Grand Winner title either.

Replacement List

- 1. You may sign up for the **Replacement List** when a category is full (32) by selecting your desire category during the normal registration process, after which payment will not be requested and your entry will be listed as Replacement List 'Category'.
- 2. The Replacement list is **only** to as a means of contacting the athlete if an entry declares their absence prior to the event. It does in **NO WAY** imply or suggest that the athlete has been registered for the event, or that the athlete has been promised a place in the event.

Contacting a Replacement

- 1. If an absence is confirmed via WKF, then, the first registered athlete will be contacted immediately **by email** with instructions to complete their payment within a strict 24 hours.
- 2. Failure to complete the registration <u>within the 24 hours</u> will lead to the complete removal of the entry and the next person on the replacement list will be contacted.
- 3. After the registration closes, names can still be put manually onto the replacement list manually by writing the WKF (wkf@wkf.net) up to 7 days before the competition. Title: PL Replacement List + (event) + (WKF ID)

COACH REGISTRATION

Individuals and National Federations are responsible for the quality of the entered registration data.

The online registration of athletes will be openly disclosed for everyone from the beginning, thus allowing consultation by WKF NFs of the competitors registered in real time.

Any issue regarding the online registration must be notified to the software provider and to the WKF, at the latest five days before the first day of competition, in order to allow its consideration without altering the smooth running of the process.

Fifteen days before the start of the event the online registration will close.

9.2 Entry Fee

The entry fee is € 150 per each individual entry.

9.3 Payment

All payments must be processed through the ONLINE PAYMENT PLATFORM. Onsite payments will NOT be accepted.

9.4 Official Accreditation

The official accreditation will take place on Thursday, 25/01/2024, from 10.00 a.m. to 16.00 p.m. at the Pierre de Coubertin Stadium, Court n°3.





If changes are required during the official registration session, due to incorrect or missing registration data, a fee of € 50 is charged for each change.

At registration, accreditation cards will be issued with the participants main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be worn at all times during the event.

The athlete's accreditation must contain an updated photograph that allows the athlete to be identifiable throughout the event.

Only members of national federations that are recognized by the WKF are admitted participating, as per the Karate 1 - Premier League Organising Rules 2024.

All participants must submit an official document (passport or other valid ID card) for the identification and validation at the accreditation session.

The accreditation of all the competitors must be done by the athlete or the athlete's coach, in person and bringing the athlete's passport or other valid ID at the accreditation session.

The competitor who has not collected, either personally or through his/her coach, the accreditation during the official registration, will not be included in the draw.

The weighing will be carried out immediately after receiving the accreditation, those athletes who do not attend the weighing will not be included in the draw.

10. MANDATORY DOCUMENTS

MANDATORY DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED AT THE OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION

At the onsite registration, all participants (Coaches, Athletes, Referees, Officials) must submit a printed and signed Waiver of Liability Form.

12. BACK NUMBERS

If the back number is not properly sewn, it can be a reason for disqualification.





13. WKF COACH PROGRAMME

According to the WKF Coach Educational Programme, the minimum certification required to take part in Karate 1 – Premier League events is the "Kumite or Kata certification" (level 2). To obtain such certification, coaches must pass the corresponding Kumite or Kata examination.

The Kumite or Kata coach licence can be obtained

- through the WKF E-learning platform for Coaches. https://www.elearning-wkf.net/
- or by attending to one of the Programmes for Coaches that the WKF holds in official events.

A WKF Programme for Coaches will be held in all Karate 1 - Premier League events 2024.

Only coaches in possession of the "WKF Accredited Coach" level have access to the "WKF Kumite or Kata certification".





19.2 How to get to Paris

By Air:

Most international travelers arrive in Paris via Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) or Orly Airport (ORY). These airports have excellent connections to the city center by train, bus, or taxi.

By Train:

The Eurostar high-speed train connects Paris to major European cities, including London, Brussels, and Amsterdam, making it a convenient option for travelers coming from these destinations.

By Car:

If you're already in Europe and prefer driving, you can reach Paris by car. Be aware of parking restrictions and consider traffic conditions, especially during peak hours.

By Bus:

Several long-distance bus companies offer services to Paris from various European cities. It's usually a budget-friendly option, but the journey may take longer than by train or plane.





From Charles de Gaulle Airport (CDG) to the center of Paris

RER B Train:

The RER B train is a popular and cost-effective option. The CDGVAL shuttle train connects the airport terminals to the RER B station. From there, you can take the RER B train to various central locations in Paris, including Gare du Nord, Châtelet-Les Halles, and Saint-Michel-Notre-Dame. This journey typically takes around 30-40 minutes by train.

Orlybus:

<u>Tramway T7 + Metro:</u>

The T7 tram connects Orly Airport to the Villejuif - Louis Aragon metro station on Line 7. From there, you can take Line 7 of the Paris Metro to reach central locations in the city. The entire journey may take around 30-40 minutes.

Taxi:

Taxis are available at Orly Airport. The travel time by taxi to the city center typically ranges from 30 to 45 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

Private Transfer:

Consider booking a private transfer in advance if you prefer a more comfortable and hassle-free option, especially if you have a lot of luggage or are traveling with a group.

Ridesharing Services:

Ridesharing services like Uber are also available at Orly Airport, offering a convenient door-to-door option.
