3. CITY / COUNTRY INFORMATION

About City

The capital city Tbilisi is situated on the banks of the Kura River, in the heart of Georgia. This vibrant urban center is renowned for its rich history that spans over centuries. 4. HOW TO GET TO CITY

4.1 How to get to City

By Airplane

Tbilisi is served by the Tbilisi International Airport (TBS), which has connections to various international destinations. You can book flights directly to Tbilisi or connect through major European and Middle Eastern airports. Once you land at the airport, you can easily reach the city center using taxis, airport shuttles, or ride-sharing services.

There is also other airport that you can consider (with low cost airline options): Kutaisi International airport is 250 km away from Tbilisi city centre, which evens approximately four hours by car.

4.2 Practical Information

Language

The official language is Georgian. English is not widely spoken, especially in rural areas, so learning a few basic phrases in Georgian could be helpful.

Currency

The currency used in Georgia is the Georgian Lari (GEL).

Financial Services and Banking Hours

Regular banking hours are Monday to Friday from 10:00 to 18:00, on Saturday from 10:00 to 14:00. All banks are closed on Sunday, and national holidays.

Major credit cards are accepted in most business establishments.

Most shops and restaurants will accept major international credit cards e.g. Visa, MasterCard, American Express Card. Local markets accept cash only.

Taxes

VAT (18 %) is collected in the entire country for all services and products.

Tax free shopping is available to international guests only at licensed stores.

A passport is required when shopping tax free.

Georgian TAX FREE shopping rules are:

- 200 GEL from one shop at one time.
- You may not use the product before tax free inspection.
- The tax return is only partial, not the full 18 % VAT.
- You have to leave Georgia within 3 months of the purchase.
- You need a stamped and signed VAT refund receipt from the seller.
- The product must be in a plastic or a paper bag sealed by the seller.
- You must exit the country from an International airport (Tbilisi, Kutaisi or Batumi)

Georgia is located in the South Caucasus region of Eurasia, bordered by Russia to the north, Azerbaijan to the southeast, Armenia to the south, and Turkey to the southwest. It also has a coastline along the Black Sea to the west.

Tbilisi has a diverse climate with distinct seasons. During the the Championship temperature is between -3°C to 8°C.

10.1 Course for EKF Coaches

Please be informed that in coincidence with the upcoming EKF Karate Cadet, Junior & U21 Championships 2024 an EKF Course for Coaches will be held in Tbilisi (Georgia)

REMEMBER!!! It is possible to homologate a WKF Kumite and/or Kata Coach (coach level 2) license by the EKF.

To do so, you must fill in the form “Request for the Homologation of a WKF Coach Certification by the EKF” and send it to the e-mail; ekf@ekf.com.es, together with the bank proof of payment of the homologation fee before the online registration deadline.

After receiving the written approval of EKF homologation, you can register to officiate as a coach at the event.

The WKF Accredited Coach license (coach level 1) is not homologated by the EKF.

After the online registration closes on January 18th, 2024, no homologations will be accepted.

The minimum level required for coaches to take part in EKF Championships is the:

“EKF Kumite/Kata Coach” certification (coach level 2)

In case a WKF Kumite and/or Kata Coach license is not homologated by the EKF, any coach who wants to officiate at the event must first register and obtain the EKF Accredited Coach certification (coach level 1) to register and attend the Kumite/Kata examination (coach level 2).

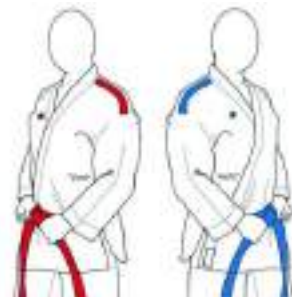

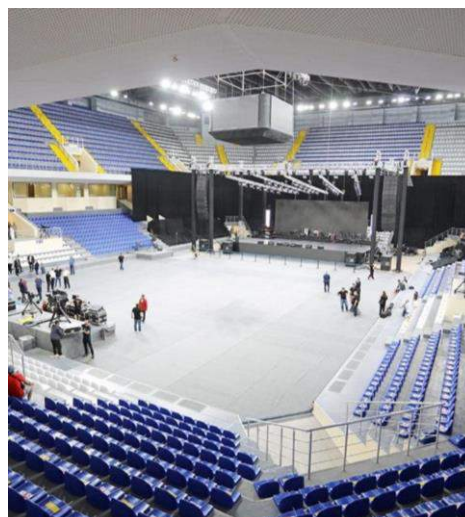
15. COMPETITION VENUE
